POSSIBLE REASONS FOR RECOMMENDING A GE COURSE	
Column Label	Formal Description
Important	The course is necessary, essential, or fundamental. It provides important basic skills/knowledge.
Enlightening	The course widens a student's perspective, stimulates awareness (on politics, cultural diversity, gender sensitivity, environment etc.) and/or trains critical thinking
Appreciation	The course encourages appreciation of new ideas and/or subject matter (e.g. appreciation of arts, appreciation of math concepts etc.)
Learning	The course is informative or value-adding. It provides opportunities to better understand a subject matter, and/or broadens a student's experience and/or knowledge. (learn something new)
Confidence	The course develops or improves a student's self-confidence (mostly about expressing ideas and speaking in public).
Skills	The course develops a skill (e.g. technical writing, public speaking, logical reasoning etc.).
Practical	The course provides helpful, useful or relevant lessons, i.e. relevant to a student's future, degree program or daily life.
Holistic	The course is vital for a holistic education and/or a student's character improvement.
Likeable	The course is fun, light/easy, enjoyable, refreshing, or interesting.
Preference	The course should be taken based on preference. It is recommended but not necessary.
Required	OTHERS: The course is required (e.g. certain number of units required for Law School).
PHSociety	The course stimulates deeper understanding of the Philippine culture, history or society, and/or molds students to become responsible Filipino citizens.
TatakUP	The course contributes to a unique learning experience or defines what is "UP education" or "UP life" (i.e. Tatak UP).
Grade	OTHERS: The course results to a high grade.
Teacher	The teacher of the course is great or commendable (Teacher Factor).
