'Sintang Dalisay' retells the tragic tale of two star-crossed lovers, Rashiddin and Jamila, and their respective families, the Mustaphas and the Kalimuddins, who are mired in an age-old hatred for each other.

It is told using dance, song, drama and live music. The dance is drawn from the igal, a tradition of the Sama in South Ubian and Sitangkai, Tawi-Tawi, while the music draws from several Philippine indigenous musical traditions yet anchored in the kulintangan rhythms of the Sulu archipelago. It is based on the awit version of G.D. Roke entitled "Ang Sintang Dalisay ni Julieta at Romeo" (1901) and on Rolando Tinio's translation of Shakespeare's text of Romeo and Juliet.

The lecture reiterates long-run arguments about the need for greater political participation of women in Philippine politics. United Nations efforts have stressed the importance of greater representation of women in the decision-making bodies, and has gradually pushed for that in its international agenda. In the Beijing Platform for Action in 1995, the participants argued for 50/50 representation of male and female in government. This proved difficult, and 30 percent female representation was targeted.
