- 4. Nominee's plans for the Institute in broad terms, including his/her flagship programs and ideas for a smooth transition.

<u>Who May be Nominated</u>: The nominee need not be a faculty member of UP at the time of nomination. The nominee must possess the following minimum qualifications and requirements:

1. Commitment to the values, ideals, and mandates of the University, including honor and excellence, innovation and knowledge generation and dissemination, and public service;

- 2. Solid background, distinction or outstanding credentials in the field of the Institute, including training, research, consultancy, and extension service;
- 3. Filipino citizenship;
- 4. Strong leadership qualities and administrative or managerial capability;
- 5. Willingness to serve;

6. Consideration of resource generation as an important function of the position;

7. Clean personal records free of administrative, civil, or criminal conviction; and

8. PhD degree or equivalent advanced training and education.
