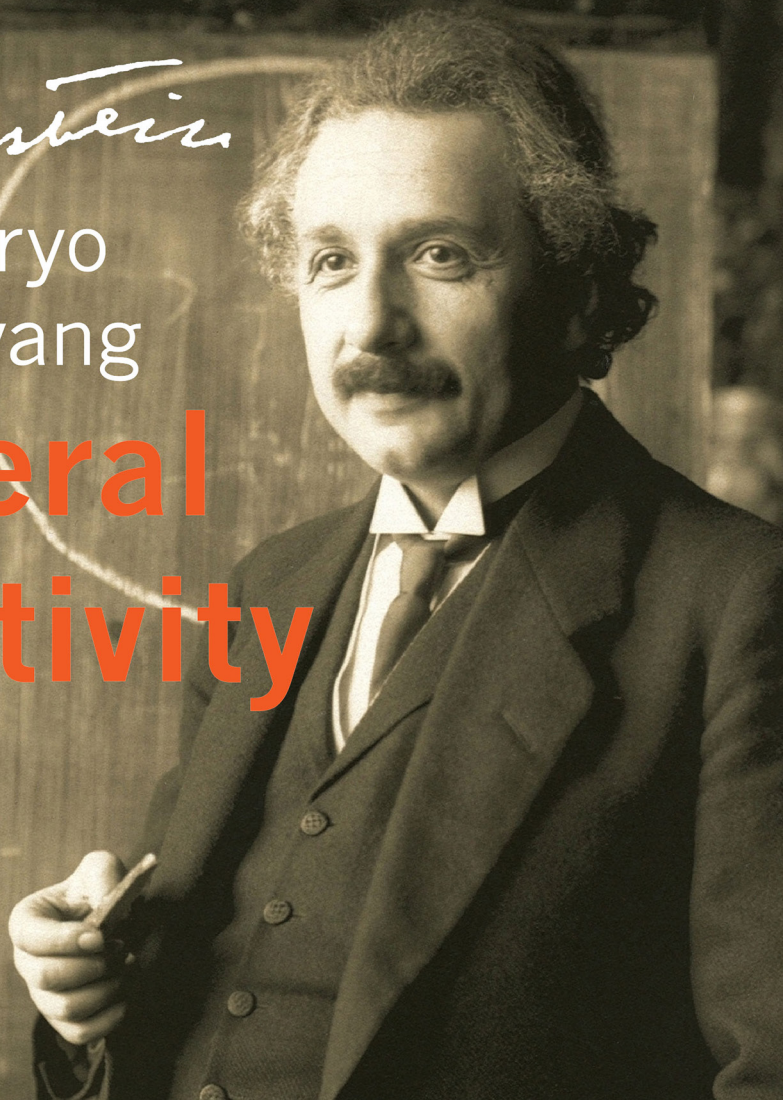

Silence on Climate Change and the Fury of Natural Disasters

A seminar about the threats of climate change to the global community by Dr. Vinod Thomas, Director General of Independent Evaluation at the Asian Development Bank.

Thomas presentation highlights the "relationship between the increase of climate-related natural disasters worldwide, and proxy variables representing climate change—temperature, precipitation and atmospheric accumulation of carbon dioxide—as an underlying global factor." His talk, which will feature special emphasis on the Philippines, touches on the past flaws in development thinking that have led to the neglect of environmental concerns. Thomas highlights important lessons learned regarding sustainable development and some policy directions to consider as we move forward.

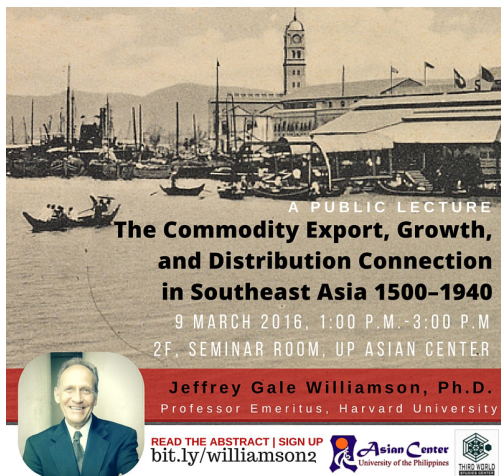
