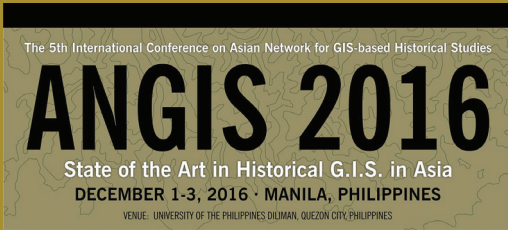

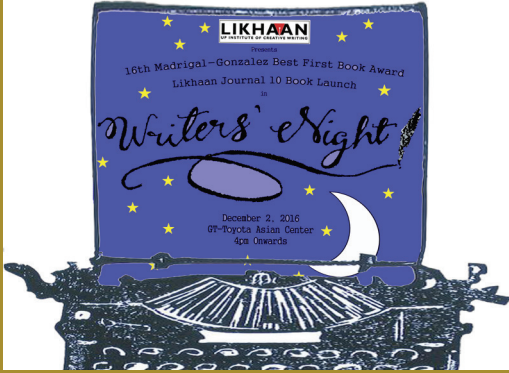

SPATIAL TERRITORIES: Artistic form in the production of space

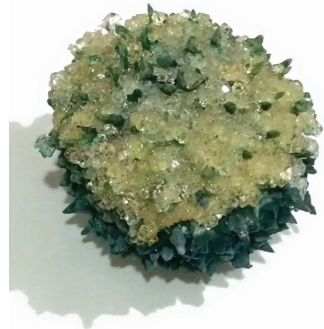

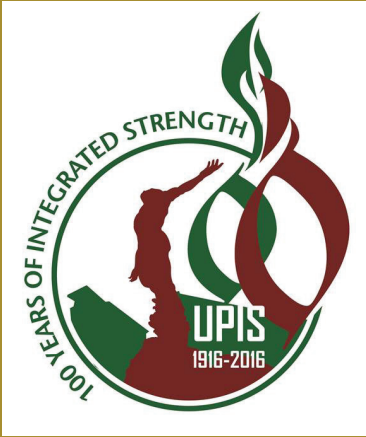

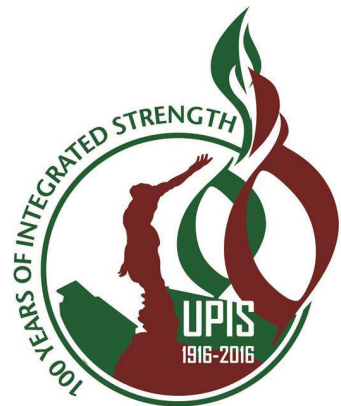
UPIS Battle of the Bands 2016
