Lakad Gunita First Quarter Storm and Diliman Commune Memory Walk in UP Diliman

The First Quarter Storm of 1970 and the Diliman Commune of 1971 occurred as a reaction to the worsening economic conditions of the time. These events displayed the response of a dissatisfied people who chose activism and militancy amidst threats of political persecution from the Marcos administration. Looking at the narrative and legacy of these events is crucial in producing a better understanding of the historical circumstances that ultimately led to the declaration of Martial Law in 1972.

To celebrate the legacy of these student-led protests, the UP Department of History will conduct a memory walk which will revisit the key landmarks of activism within the UP Diliman campus.
