


Mandatory Continuing Legal Education (MCLE)

The Rohingya Conundrum: Its Significance for International Studies

Seminar Room, UP Asian Center 2-4 p.m.

This lecture will focus on three fundamental issues: the Rohingya conundrum, possible solutions and its implications in international studies.

The conflict between Rohingya, a Muslim minority in Rakhine state in western Myanmar (Burma), and the Rakhine Buddhists has been an international concern since 2012 when violence first erupted in recent years.

The protracted violence is a threat not only to Myanmar's internal peace and stability but also for the country's relations with the international community, particularly its immediate neighbor Bangladesh and the Muslim-majority countries in Southeast Asia, such as Malaysia and Indonesia, that have expressed concerns over the Rohingyas' treatment in the past.

Handel's Messiah


Abelardo Hall Auditorium 6:30 p.m.


