

Call for Nominations to the Deanship of the College of Mass Communication

The Nomination Committee for the Deanship of the College of Mass Communication (CMC) shall accept nominations from 8:00 AM, Monday, November 6, 2018 to 12 NN, Friday, November 16, 2018. Please submit the following documents (in both printed copies with original signatures as appropriate and soft copies in CD-ROM or USB drive) within office hours to the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs (Tel. Nos. 981-8500 Loc. 2587 or 2588; 9282886).

1. Nominator(s)' signed nomination letter containing the justification of the nomination (please include current contact details of the (first) nominator);
2. Nominee's summarized curriculum vitae (at most four (4) pages);
3. Nominee's signed letter of acceptance of nomination stating willingness to serve as Dean; and
4. Nominee's plans for the unit, in broad terms, to include his/her flagship programs and ideas for smooth transition.

WHO MAY NOMINATE: Personnel of the College of Mass Communication (CMC), students and alumni, others from outside the College, interested candidates.

WHO MAY BE NOMINATED: The nominee need not be a faculty member at the time of nomination. Should s/he be appointed, s/he must have a faculty appointment. The nominee must possess the following minimum requirements:

- Commitment to academic freedom and the values and ideals of the University;
- Distinction or outstanding academic credentials in the nominee's chosen field of expertise which should be along the lines of CMC's disciplines or fields;
- A graduate degree: At least a Master's degree, preferably PhD (or the equivalent) degree;
- Filipino citizen;
- Leadership qualities and administrative or managerial capability;
- Must be willing to serve; and
- Must consider resource generation an important function of the position.
