This course is designed to introduce and explore the art of photography as a primary skill needed in film production. Composition, framing, lighting, camera settings and photo editing are included in the topic discussions as well. The workshop falls within the scope of digital technology and will also take time in thoroughly discussing the parts and operations of a digital camera.

Workshop fee is P6,000.

UP Integrated School (UPIS) Pagtatapos 2019

UPIS 2019 graduation theme is "Malayang Iskolar, Tumitindig para sa Kasarinlang Iniibig." The theme challenges the graduates to respond to current threats to the country's sovereignty.

Batch 2019 will be donning the "Sablay" especially designed for high school graduates of UP – the first batch to do so. The Sablay features a stylized "pako" or fern in its sprouting phase which symbolizes youth. The new design is part of the recommendations submitted by the University's Committee on the Sablay in 2016. The new sablay was designed by Prof. Abraham Sakili, PhD from the Department of Art Studies of the UPD College of Arts and Letters. Sakili is also a board member of the National Historical Commission.

Oliver "Ollie" Teves, The Philippine Daily Inquirer's desk editor, will be this year's guest speaker. Teves is a seasoned reporter/editor with stints at the Kyodo News Service Manila Bureau, The Associated Press Manila



Bureau and CNN Philippines. Teves graduated from UP High (now UP Integrated School) in 1973. He earned his bachelor's degree (AB Philippine Studies) from UPD in 1981.

Unbeknownst to many, Teves was the person who coined the term "Iskolar ng Bayan," a term used to describe students and graduates of UP. He first used the term in his essay "Hirap sa Sasakyan ang Iskolar ng Bayan" which was published in the Philippine Collegian in 1975. It was originally an essay he submitted for his Creative Writing class.
