Pagdampig: Negros Human Rights Situationer

2-5 p.m. Asian Center

The Defend Negros #StopTheAttacks Network is holding a public forum on the spate of killings in Negros Island that has so far claimed 87 lives. All of the victims were unarmed civilians (lawyers, teachers, rights defenders, activists, church people, and farmers) of which the youngest is a 1-year-old boy killed alongside his father. Many were gunned down in their own homes or in makeshift huts, several while in their sleep. Fifteen were killed from July 23 to 28.



6 p.m. (Exhibit opening) 1F, 3F Galleries, UP Vargas Museum

Exhibiting for the first time in his home country, the activist, migrant and artist Noel Ed De Leon gathers old and new found object assemblages, installations, readymades, multi-media sculptures, paintings and photographs in a month-long exhibition at the Vargas Museum. 1,976 Objects embodies the current moment in De Leon's ongoing artistic process as he gathers and reanimates singular, communal and cultural histories told through material objects. He explores anxieties around memory and maps traces of history in the links between living beings and non-living things, and in the body as it assumes a physical relationship with objects and surroundings over time.

The exhibit will be from Aug. 9 to Sept. 7, Tuesdays to Saturdays, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

About the artist:

Born in Pangasinan in 1976, De Leon moved to Manila and graduated with a degree in architecture before he and his wife Leah migrated to the United Kingdom in 2007. A year later the recession hit, he turned from interior design to art to signify his experiences and passions.

He met David Medalla, a pioneer in kinetic and performative practice, in 2012 and was invited to participate in the London Biennale. The gripping and interactive performance, "Life As I Know It," was the first of many, marking De Leon's steady progression away from figurative painting to his current practice of experimentation with installation, multi-media sculpture, art made with found and collected objects, and performance. Since then, he has mounted "Tokens of a Time Gone By: Reanimating History as Art in the Work of Noel Ed De Leon," a major solo exhibition at the Philippine Embassy of London (2014), and participated in group exhibitions like Southeast Asia Performance Collection at the Haus der Kunst, Germany (2019) among others.

He is currently co-director of Batubalani Art Projects, a London-based non-profit organization dedicated to promoting Philippine modern and contemporary art.


