Who may nominate:


Personnel of the Institute, its students and alumni, others from outside of the Institute, interested candidates.

1. A strong commitment to both academic freedom and academic excellence as well as the values, ideals, and purposes of the University consistent with its unique and distinctive leadership role in higher education and development (RA 9500, Secs. 3, 5, and 6)
2. Distinction or outstanding academic credentials in the nominee's field of expertise which should be along the lines of the college's/unit's disciplines or fields
3. Filipino citizenship
4. Leadership qualities coupled with administrative or managerial capability
5. Willingness to serve full term of three (3) years
6. Resource generation capability
