- Distinction or outstanding academic credentials in the nominee's chosen field of expertise which should be along the lines of the SLIS' disciplines or fields;
- A graduate degree: At least a Master's degree, preferably PhD (or the equivalent) degree;
- Filipino citizen;
- Preferably a licensed !ibrarian;
- Leadership qualities and administrative or managerial capability;
- Must be willing to serve; and
- Must consider resource generation an important function of the position.
