#### VFA Termination: New Strategic Moves

It lessens US ability to dictate on Philippine foreign policy; enhances overall cooperation with China leading to possible solutions to the South China Sea disputes; and widens space for the country's initiatives for a more independent foreign policy.

The speaker is Ericson Baculinao, award-winning Beijing bureau chief of NBC News US television. Baculinao has lived and worked in China for the past 48 years.

Barrozo is a film music composer. She is the winner for Best Aural Design for the film "Birdshot" by Mikhail Red at the Filipino Arts and Cinema International (Facine24) in San Francisco, USA and the winner of the Best Original Soundtrack for the film "Kinatay" directed by Brillante Mendoza at the 42<sup>nd</sup> Sitges International Film Festival 2009 in Spain. She also earned recognition for scoring films such as "10,000 Hours" directed by Joyce Bernal at the 39<sup>th</sup> Metro Manila Film Festival and "Ka Oryang" directed by Sari Lluch Dalena at the CinemaOne Originals Film Festival 2011.

Tey Clamor (Cinematography Masterclass / 2-5 pm / March 7 / UPFI Videotheque)

Clamor is a cinematographer who received her BA in Film from the UP Film Institute and participated in the Berlinale Talent Campus, Germany in 2006. She received her first break as a Director of Photography in 2015 for the film "Sleepless" and since then completed 18 local feature films including recent films "Tayo Sa Huling Buwan Ng Taon," "Metamorphosis," "Isa Pa With Feelings," and "Babae at Baril." Her first international nomination came in 2018 for the film "Maestra" (Teacher) in the Philadelphia Independent Film Awards.

#### Marielle Hizon (Production Design Masterclass / 2-5 pm / March 14 / UPFI Film Studio)

Hizon is a freelance production designer and actress. She won production design awards for "Kung Paano Hinihintay ang Dapithapon" (2018) at the Cinemalaya Independent Film Festival, "Baconaua" (2017) at the Young Critics Circle, "Lila" (2016) for Sinag Maynila Film Festival and "Blue Bustamante" (2013) at the Cinema One Originals Digital Film Festival.



#### Angeli Bayani (Acting Masterclass / 9–12 nn / March 28 / UPFI Cine Adarna)

Bayani is best known for starring in Philippine art-house and independent films notably those by Lav Diaz: "Melancholia" (2008) and "Norte, the End of History" (2013) for which she won the 2014 Gawad Urian Award for Best Actress.
