The UP Diliman Gender Office will launch the **2020 UP Diliman Gender and Development Committee Professional Development Training Series** education this **October 2020** via Zoom. This will provide UPD GAD Committee members with four sessions of GAD capability building training and to equip them for GAD Focal Point System (GFPS) work. It shall cover the following topics and activities:

- *Tools for GAD Focal Point System Work: "Harmonized Gender and Development Guidelines (HGDG) and the PCW Memorandum on the GAD Plan and Budget"*
- *Gender and Development Education: "Living with Family Members from Vulnerable Populations in the Time of COVID-19"*

To culminate the GAD Professional Training Series, the UPDGO will convene the **9<sup>th</sup> UP Diliman Gender and Development (GAD) Summit** with the theme *"Implications of COVID and the New Normal on GAD Work: Approaches and Activities"* in **November 2020**, via Zoom. The Summit is conducted annually with the aim of gathering the GAD committees to share their GAD work and to enhance their knowledge and skills on gender mainstreaming.
