## Donations and Fundraising

## **UPDate was able to document 36 donation/fundraising drives.**

f the 36, UP Diliman (UPD) had seven donation/fundraising drives organized by academic units and 29 that were organized by student organizations, non-academic units and alumni groups. The seven academic units are the College of Arts and Letters (CAL), College of Mass Communication (CMC), College of Music (CMu), School of Labor and Industrial Relations (SOLAIR), Technology Management Center (TMC), College of Social Sciences and Philosophy (CSSP) and the School of Statistics (STAT).

These units belong to UPD's four academic clusters: Arts and Letters (CAL, CMC and CMu), Management and Economics (SOLAIR and TMC), Social Sciences and Law (CSSP), and Science and Technology (STAT). Meanwhile, the 29 donation/fundraising drives comprised 12 student organizations, two non-academic units, three alumni groups, and 12 student organizations and non-academic units with co-organizers/partner organizations.
