Guidelines for Year-End Unit Celebrations

- 1. Virtual celebrations/programs are preferred.
- 2. Face-to-face celebrations may be allowed if these guidelines are observed:
 - a. All attendees must be fully vaccinated, and all recommended health protocols are followed.
 - b. An outdoor/open-air setup is highly advised with all recommended health protocols strictly followed.
 - c. Celebrations held indoors must have adequate ventilation.
 Please see the <u>F2F Ventilation Checklist/Guidelines</u> to know how to make the indoor venue safe for attendees.



Guidelines for Year-End Unit Celebrations

- 3. Activities allowed during face-to-face celebrations:
 - a. Non-contact games and similar non-contact activities are allowed provided all participants wear a well-fitted mask and observe physical distancing of at least two (2) meters.
 - b. Singing/karaoke/videoke may be allowed if the following guidelines are observed:
 - The performance area is below a running exhaust fan or right next to an electric fan blowing air out to an open window.
 - All the performers remain masked during their turn.
 - · Microphones are disinfected with 70% alcohol after each use.



Guidelines for Year-End Unit Celebrations

- 4. Duration of each event should be set and observed. Overnight events are not allowed.
- 5. Parties and programs held outside the UPD campus will be the responsibility of department heads and/or organizers.





Food

- 1. Packed meals portioned for individuals and wrapped well are preferred even in an outdoor/open-air setup.
- 2. Specific dining areas for each of the attendees must be identified and designated at the start of the event.
- 3. Eating together (eating within the same space at the same time) will only be allowed in an outdoor/open-air setup.
- 4. Eating in groups in enclosed spaces is prohibited.
- 5. Food should be distributed in an efficient and organized manner.
- 6. No blowing out of candles on cakes.







Photoshoots and other similar activities

- 1. Group photos may be allowed if masks are not removed, and participants are positioned two (2) meters apart.
- 2. A designated person should oversee the photo session and make sure that health protocols are observed.
- Group photos may be done in an enclosed space as long as the room is adequately ventilated (see <u>F2F Ventilation Checklist/</u> <u>Guidelines</u> on how to ensure this).
