- 1. Nominator/s' signed nomination letter containing the justification for the nomination and the contact details of the (first) nominator
- 2. Nominee's summarized curriculum vitae (three pages at most)
- 3. Nominee's signed letter of acceptance of the nomination, stating willingness to serve as dean
- 4. Nominee's vision and plans for SURP in broad terms, including his/her flagship programs

## 2022 Call for Nominations to the Deanship of the UP Diliman School of Urban and Regional Planning

#### **Who May Nominate:**

SURP faculty, REPS, administrative personnel, students, and alumni; UP constituents; and other interested stakeholders

### Who May be Nominated:

The nominee must possess the following minimum qualifications:

- 1. Filipino citizen
- 2. Commitment to academic freedom and the values and ideals of the University
- 3. Distinction or outstanding academic credentials in the nominee's field of expertise which should be along the lines of SURP's disciplines or fields
- 4. Leadership qualities and administrative capability
- 5. Must be willing to serve as dean
- 6. Must consider resource generation an important function of the position

The nominee need not be a faculty member at the time of nomination. Should s/he be appointed, s/he must have a faculty appointment.
