# WHO MAY BE NOMINATED:

The nominee must possess the following minimum qualifications:

- 1. Filipino citizen
- 2. Commitment to academic freedom and values and ideals of the University
- 3. Distinction or outstanding academic credentials in the nominee's field of expertise which should be along the lines of UP CIS' disciplines or fields
- 4. Leadership qualities and administrative capability
- 5. Must be willing to serve as Director
- 6. Must consider resource generation an important function of the position The nominee need not be a faculty member at the time of nomination. Should s/he be appointed, s/he must have a faculty appointment.
