WHO MAY NOMINATE:

UP CIS faculty and faculty affiliates, administrative personnel, students, UP constituents and other interested stakeholders.

WHO MAY BE NOMINATED:

The nominee must possess the following minimum qualifications:

1. Filipino citizen
2. Commitment to academic freedom and values and ideals of the University
3. Distinction or outstanding academic credentials in the nominee's field of expertise which should be along the lines of UP CIS' disciplines or fields
4. Leadership qualities and administrative capability
5. Must be willing to serve as Director
6. Must consider resource generation an important function of the position

The nominee need not be a faculty member at the time of nomination. Should s/he be appointed, s/he must have a faculty appointment.
