Who May NOMINATE:

College of Education faculty, REPS, administrative staff, students and alumni, UP constituents and other interested stakeholders

Who May be NOMINATED:

The Nominee for Dean must possess the following minimum qualifications:

- 1. Filipino citizen
- 2. Commitment to academic freedom and values and ideals of the University
- 3. Distinction or outstanding academic credentials in the Nominee's field of expertise, which should be along the lines of the College of Educations disciplines/fields
- 4. Leadership qualities and administrative capability
- 5. Must be willing to serve as Dean
- 6. Must consider resource generation an important function of the position

The Nominee need not be a faculty member at the time of the nomination. Should s/he be appointed Dean, s/he must by then have a faculty appointment.
