Subject : **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC SCHEME AND ROAD CLOSURES  
(JAN 31 – FEB 6, 2022)**

There will be a temporary change in traffic scheme in the campus starting 8:00 AM on January 31, 2022 (Monday) to 9:00 PM on February 6, 2022 (Sunday). The road closures will ensure smooth operations for the preparatory activities and actual conduct of the Bar Exam that will be held in UP Diliman.

1. The following roads will be closed to the public (motorists, pedestrians and cyclists):
  - Academic Oval including E. Guerrero St.
  - Portion of University Ave. from E. Jacinto Ave. to Oblation Plaza
  - Portion of Magsaysay Ave. from E. Guerrero St. to Balagtas St.
  - Portion of Quirino Ave. from Regidor St. to Kalaw St.
  - Portion of P. Velasquez St. from Marine Science Institute to Quirino Ave.
  - Connecting roads to the Academic Oval
    - E. Guerrero St. from Magsaysay Ave. to Academic Oval
    - Agoncillo St. from Magsaysay Ave. to Academic Oval
    - Apacible St. from Magsaysay Ave. to Academic Oval
    - Roces St. from JP Laurel St. to Academic Oval
    - Regidor St. from Quirino Ave. to Academic Oval
    - Africa St. from Quirino Ave. to Academic Oval
2. Portion of Magsaysay St. from gate to E. Guerrero St. will be one way eastbound;
3. Portion of E. Guerrero St. From Magsaysay St. to JP Laurel St. will be one way northbound; and
4. Magsaysay portal/gate will be open as ingress only.

The other gates/portals (University Ave, E. Jacinto St., P. Velasquez St., Quirino Ave.) will be open with their usual restrictions (UPD vehicle sticker and/or UP ID only).

Only authorized individuals and vehicles will be allowed entry to the restricted areas.

The public are advised to seek alternative routes as may be necessary. Kindly see attached map for your guidance. Thank you.

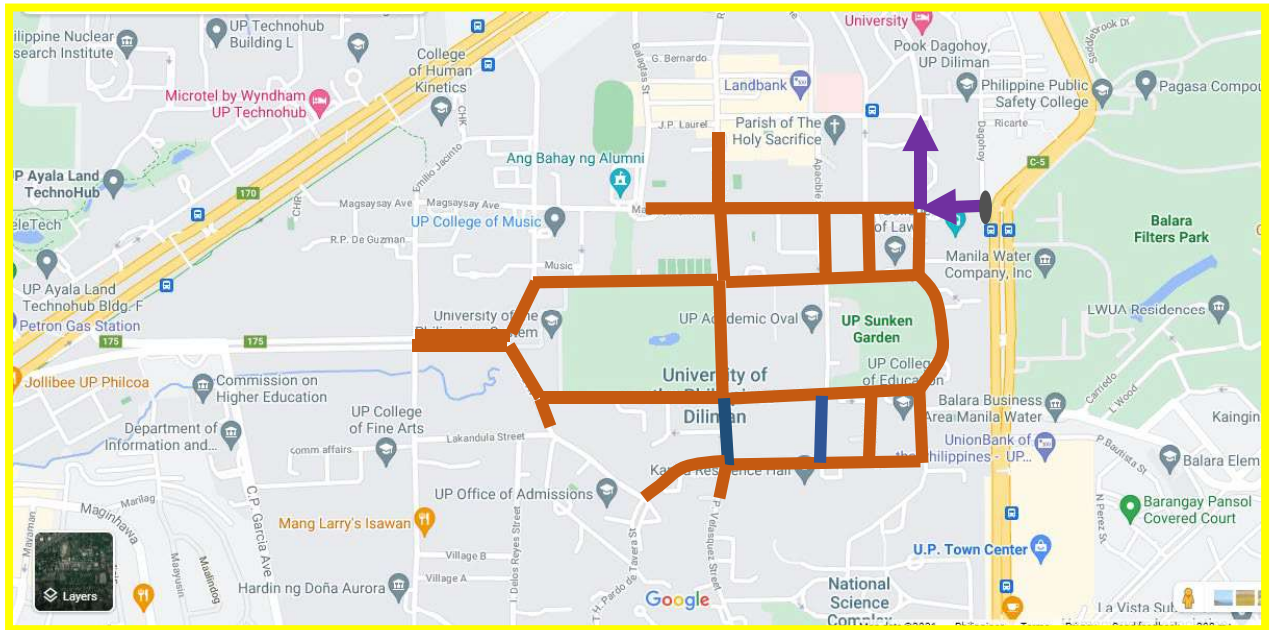
