3rd UP Diliman Professional Development Training Series 2022: Gender-Based Violence First Responder Training and the 13th UP Diliman Gender and Development (GAD) Summit 2022

The UP Diliman Gender Office will be hosting the 13th UP Diliman Gender and Development (GAD) Summit 2022 and conducting the 3rd UP Diliman Professional Development Training Series 2022: Gender-Based Violence First Responder Training this 23-25 November 2022 as part of UPDGO's opening activities for the 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women, which begins on 25 November - the International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women (IDEVAW). These are both in-person activities to be held at Alcantara Hall (third floor), UP Student Union Building, University of the Philippines Diliman.

The **3rd UP Diliman Professional Development Training Series 2022: Gender-Based Violence First Responder Training** is a three-day training seminar to be held on **23-24 November 2022** from **8:00AM** to **5:00PM** and on **25 November 2022** from **8:00AM** to **12:00NN**. The PDTS will be focused on *Training for UP Diliman GAD Committee members as Counseling First Responders for Gender-Based Violence*. This will be the first in-person PDTS since its launch in 2020.

The PDTS shall be followed by the 13th UP Diliman Gender and Development Summit 2022 to be held on 25 November 2022 from 1:00PM to 5:00PM. This will be the first in-person GAD Summit to be held since 2019, and will include GAD Committee fellowship, presentation of GAD accomplishments, and sharing of best practices in GAD of all units and colleges across UP Diliman. We shall be celebrating *IDEVAW - the International Day for the Elimination and Violence Against Women* through GAD education and awareness-raising briefings and two musical performances.

You are enjoined to cooperate with the UPDGO and have all GAD Committees along with the respective heads and key officials of all colleges and units participate in the Professional Development Training Series and the 13th UP Diliman GAD Summit **on official time**. Kindly ensure that you confirm your participation in the 13th UP Diliman GAD Summit here. You may also update your GAD Committee directory information here.

For colleges and units that have yet to form GAD Committees or assign GAD representatives, kindly refer to **Memorandum No. FRN-20-086 dated 16 September 2020 re the formation of GAD Committees, assignment of GAD representatives**: "Toward the fulfillment of the University's commitment to the continued capacity building of the UPD GAD FPS and the effective coordination, implementation, and preparation of the Gender and Development Accomplishment Report (GAD AR) in accordance with SECTION 37 of the

MAGNA CARTA OF WOMEN Implementing Rules and Regulations, you are mandated to ensure that your college / unit / office / department has an active GAD Committee with at least three (3) appointed members (aside from heads of units/offices/departments/colleges, who are de facto GAD Committee members)."
