Subject : **Implementation of the No Sticker, No Entry Policy**

As part of the *No Sticker, No Entry Policy*, the following shall be implemented in all portals of the university beginning **16 January 2023** (3rd Monday of January):

- The **No UP Vehicle Sticker, No Entry/Exit** at the Velasquez and Ylanan portals;
- The **No UP Vehicle Sticker** and the **No ID, No Entry-Exit** at the Magsaysay, Jacinto, and Purok Aguinaldo portals; and
- Vehicles with no UP sticker can only enter thru the University Avenue portal but shall be subject to inspection.

To apply for the UPD vehicle sticker, please refer to the requirements and procedure of *Memorandum No. LMTB – 22 – 07* (see attached).

Subject : **UP Vehicle Sticker for Academic Year 2022 - 2023**

The UP vehicle sticker for AY 2022-2023 shall be issued to eligible applicants starting 5 October 2022. The following procedure shall be observed:

1. Eligibility and Fees

Applicants must be either one of the following: University Official, faculty, REPS, Administrative Staff, student, and other UPD- connected individuals. UP Officials, faculty, REPS and administrative staff are eligible for one complimentary sticker. A maximum of two (2) vehicle stickers can be granted per applicant.

The following fees shall apply:

Each non-UP unit (business concessionaire, government office, etc.) located within the UPD campus will be allocated a maximum of ten (10) vehicle stickers. Should there be more than 10 applications emanating from an office, the OVCCA shall request the office to submit a list of applicants in order of priority.

For faculty, REPS, and staff who will not apply for a UP vehicle sticker, but will be using Grab or taxi as mode of transportation to enter the campus, a complimentary gate pass shall be issued. - Name
- College/Unit
- Category (tenured/Non-tenured faculty, permanent/non-permanent REPS or staff)
- 4.5 cm x 3.5.cm (passport size) photo

2. Application Procedure for a Vehicle Sticker

- 2.1 Submit your application together with all the scanned requirements at <https://tinyurl.com/UPDVehicleStickerApp>. Incomplete requirements will not be processed. **Walk-in applicants will not be accepted.**
- 2.2 A staff member will verify and assess the documentary requirements and a feedback or confirmation email will be sent with online payment instructions (if applicable), and a schedule of when you can come to the office for the vehicle inspection and installation of sticker.
- 2.3 Proceed to the OVCCA located at the Lower Ground Floor in Quezon Hall on the appointed time stated in the confirmation email for verification and installation.
- 2.4 On the day of processing, the following procedure shall be observed:
Station 1- Verification of appointment
Station 2- Vehicle inspection and installation of sticker

2.5 Special Application Process for Professors Emeriti

In consideration of their status, Professors Emeriti only need to set an appointment with OVCCA at telephone number 89282947, when applying for a vehicle sticker. The OVCCA staff shall process the request and place the vehicle sticker on the agreed schedule.

3. Requirements

Prepare ahead the following requirements for online submission:

3.1 Basic Requirements for All Applicants:

- LTO Certificate of Registration (or Sales Invoice for new vehicle)
- LTO Official Receipt
- UP Form 5 or any proof of enrollment (for students)
- UP Identification Card

3.2 Additional requirements, if applicable:

- Notarized Deed of Sale and/or company certification if applicant is not the registered owner
- Proof of contract/legal arrangement/document (for service providers)
- UPA Alumni ID (if applicable)
- Appointment Papers (for non-permanent UP Personnel)

4. OVCCA Right to Refuse Requests

The OVCCA reserves the right to refuse the installation of stickers based on but not limited to the following grounds:

- Loud muffler sound (can be a distraction to academic activities)
- Fake records
- Vehicle is different from the ones declared in the application form.
- Other reasons which are contrary to public safety and security and other pertinent laws.

5. Penalty on Misrepresentation and Unauthorized Use of UP Vehicle Sticker

Tampering and presenting fake vehicle stickers as well as university personnel and students who allow reproduction of their UP Identification Cards for purposes of gaining access through the University portals to unauthorized individuals shall be subject to the following sanctions:

6. Regulation of Entrance and Exit of Vehicles at University Portals

Please be informed that the OVCCA is targeting the start of implementation of the **No UP Vehicle Sticker, No Entry/Exit** policy on 05 December 2022. As a reminder, the following are the salient points of the policy:

- The **No UP Vehicle Sticker, No Entry/Exit** at the Velasquez and Ylanan portals;
- The **No UP Vehicle Sticker** and the **No ID, No Entry-Exit** at the Magsaysay, Jacinto, and Purok Aguinaldo portals; and
- Vehicles with no UP sticker can only enter thru the University Avenue portal but shall be subject to inspection.

7. Additional Responsibility

Along with the privilege of using the UP vehicle sticker, the University, thru Memorandum No. JECL – 19 – 21 (attached), motorists in the campus are subject to the QC DPOS system of traffic fines and violations.

Dear Chancellor Tan,

The UP Diliman Transportation Committee, at its meetings held on 31 January 2019 and 5 March 2019, proposed the following for your consideration:

1. Adopt QC-DPOS's penalties and fines for traffic violations, with an additional warning layer for first time offenders.
2. Designate JP Laurel St as a *No Parking Zone* except for the lessees of housing units on said Street. The lessees of the housing units on said street with no business renters are inconvenienced by the vehicles of clients of JP Laurel St food establishments; and
3. Implement a *one-side parking only* for both Agoncillo and Apacible Streets; two-side parking at the vicinity of the Parish of the Holy Sacrifice; one-way traffic scheme at Agoncillo St. from JP Laurel Avenue up to Osmeña Ave; and one-way traffic scheme at Apacible St. from Osmeña Ave. up to JP Laurel St.

Rest assured that the UP community shall be duly informed prior to its implementation.
