The Office of the Chancellor shall receive nominations for the deanship of the National College of Public Administration and Governance (NCPAG) from **12 to 23 January 2026 (5 p.m.)**. Please submit the following documents (both printed copies with original signatures as appropriate and soft copies on a USB drive):

1. Nominator(s)'s signed nomination letter containing the justification for the nomination (please include current contact details of the [first] nominator)
2. Nominee's summarized curriculum vitae (maximum of three pages)
3. Nominee's signed letter of acceptance of the nomination, stating willingness to serve as dean
4. Nominee's plans for the NCPAG in broad terms, including their flagship programs and ideas for a smooth transition.

Who May Nominate

NCPAG faculty, staff, students, UP alumni, and other interested stakeholders

Who May be Nominated

The nominee must possess the following minimum requirements:

1. Commitment to academic freedom, and values and ideals of the University
2. Distinction or outstanding academic credentials in the nominee's chosen field of expertise, which should be along the lines of the NCPAG's disciplines or fields
3. Filipino citizen
4. Leadership qualities and administrative or managerial capabilities
5. Willingness to serve
6. Must consider resource generation an important function of the position

The nominee does not need to be a faculty member at the time of nomination. Should they be appointed as dean, they must also have a faculty appointment.

Schedule of Activities

Related activities (e.g. public forum, interviews with stakeholders) will be held soon after the deadline for nominations (23 January 2026). The specific schedule will be announced in the coming days.
